IMPACT outreach ministries gathers passionate youth and leaders and takes them to a new area that has been identified by an existing church and/or church planter as a location for a new church plant. Through various outreaches, names are gathered and given to the church planter taking charge, and small groups begin. Living Stones, Glory ministries, and school outreaches are all tools that can be used in this process.

**EDUCATE
AND EQUIP**

As the small groups grow and are disciplined by the church planter, they look for ways to further educate and equip the members through the seminary, International school, technical training, and professional development. The church begins working on a building that best fits the needs of their community.

**GENERATE
AND REINVEST**

Our goal is to have a building and local leadership built up and running the church in about 5 years. The church planter is now ready to begin the process again. Partnering with business as mission (BAM) can provide the money needed for building and training leaders, as well as forming strategic workers to fulfill the great commission to the ends of the earth.
