World Renewal (WR) is an independent, interdenominational ministry organization. We exist to help local churches around the world fulfill the Great Commission. We do this By developing leaders and congregations who are Spiritfilled, self-sustaining, and self-reproducing.

HOLINESS

We believe living the normal Christian life means having a clean heart, pure hands, and having the power to walk in victory over the sin nature. Holiness comes from surrendering fully to the indwelling and cleansing of the Holy Spirit so that the believer has a pure heart of love for God and others and grows daily in Christian maturity, Christlikeness and practical godliness that results from walking obediently.

Our Beliefs



The Bible

We believe the Scriptures to be the inspired Word of God, without error in all that it affirms, and our final authority for faith and practice.



The Triune God

We believe in one God, creator of all things, infinitely perfect and eternally existing in three persons: the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.



God the Father

We believe in God the Father Almighty who has revealed Himself in grace, love, mercy, justice, goodness, and holiness.



Jesus the Son

We believe in Jesus as the Son of God, both fully God and fully man, born of a virgin, who died on the cross for the redemption of our sin, was physically resurrected from the dead, and ascended in his body to heaven.



The Holy Spirit

We believe in the Holy Spirit as a divine person who convicts, regenerates, and indwells believers, enabling them to live holy lives under the Lordship of Jesus Christ.



Humanity, Sin, and Salvation

We believe that humanity was created in the image of God but fell out of relationship with God through Adam and Eve's willful disobedience and distrust. Consequently, every generation is born with a corrupted, sin nature that alienates us from God. Salvation comes only through turning to Christ for pardon and cleansing from sin. God freely offers grace for all to be restored to fellowship with him through belief, and trust in Jesus Christ.



Holiness

We believe the normal Christian life means having a clean heart and pure hands and living through the Holy Spirit in victory over one's sin nature. Holiness comes from surrendering fully to the indwelling and cleansing of the Holy Spirit so that the believer has a pure heart of love for God and others and grows daily in Christian maturity, Christlikeness, and the practical godliness that result from walking obediently.



Judgement and Last Days

We believe that Jesus Christ will someday return to earth to judge the living and dead, to bring eternal life for the righteous and eternal separation for the unbelievers, and to establish his eternal kingdom in victory over evil and wickedness.



The Church

We believe in the Church as the body of Christ on earth. The church is spiritual in nature, universal in scope, holy in character, and redemptive in its life and purpose. Its purpose is to bear witness to the kingdom of God through loving fellowship, service to the world, worship of God, winning the lost, discipling believers into maturity, and proclaiming the message of salvation.



Affirmations

We affirm the classical creeds of the church in history, especially the Nicene Creed and the Apostles' Creed, as foundational expressions of Christian truth and doctrine. We affirm the Lausanne Covenant as a meaningful and vital expression of the Church's call and commitment to the Great Commission around the world.

1990

World Renewal's first missionary was Cari Orend, part of the group of 100 to go to Hungary. God began to move World Renewal from revival and renewal in America to Europe. The USA families who were reached through the Wright's ministry became the donors, leaders, and partner churches that sent WR International. But the outreaches were not planting churches, as the local churches were not prepared to receive the new believers. Our impact

- World Renewal is serving its partners in Brazil, Burundi, United Kingdom, France, Haiti, Israel, Mexico, India, Kenya, Mozambique, Nicaragua, Tanzania, Spain, as well as outreaches in Latin America, in persecuted countries, and locally to churches in the USA
- World Renewal, with its partnerships, has a presence in over 60+ countries and has ministered in 90+ countries.
- Since 1990, World Renewal has founded (estimate only because of persecuted countries) 400+ new congregations with their partners around the world.
- World Renewal, with its partners, has founded 2 orphanages (who serve/have served 150+ children in Haiti), 8+ schools (Brazil, Haiti, Tanzania, Kenya, India, and in challenging places), 2 camps (Brazil), and feed over 1000 children each school day through their partners around the world. We have 17 locations in 6 countries that help children through child sponsorship, serving around 500 children.
- World Renewal and their partners have founded the Northeast Bible Seminary (Brazil), an International Business as Missions hub (Brazil), and online and in person training for over 4,000 leaders each year through multiple Biblical training programs around the world.

Equipping for Church Planting and Discipleship

The Great Commission is to go to the ends of the earth to win the lost and disciple them in loving obedience to become mature followers of Christ. Discipleship happens best through intentional church planting, intentional discipleship to maturity, and being global-minded in our outlook. We equip for discipleship and planting by:

- Emphasizing being global, reproductive, and self-sustaining from day one.
- Provide specific training in church-planting, evangelism, and discipleship for both leaders and laity.
- Facilitating short-term mission teams: work, outreach, ministry, VBS, and prayer.
- Helping launch and support local church ministries: Celebrate Recovery, Women's ministries, orphanages, clinics, and the like.
- Coordinating networking and financial support from North American churches.
- Evangelistic ministries: revivals, crusades, and spiritual renewal events.
- Helping local churches in both the US and abroad develop a passion for engaging in missions around the world with their prayers, people, and finances.
- Serve the local church through preaching, revivals, music ministry, discipleship training, and resources as God provides.

Empowering Indigenous Leaders

Serving national and church leaders in partnership is the foundation of our ministry. We are called to support and develop these leaders so that they can disciple other leaders. We empower leaders by:

- Enabling national leaders to develop a vision and strategy and make final ministry decisions for their ministry area.
- Not owning property or facilities; all property will be owned by national churches or local groups.
- Developing leaders who make leaders.
- Equipping through mentoring, coaching, and skills training.
- Assisting with limited financial support.
- Assisting in developing networks and partnerships.
- Modeling servant leadership.
- Providing spiritual encouragement and inspiration.
- Using international training teams and not just North Americans.

Training for Biblical Leadership

Effective local churches that make disciples and have a global mission require godly, trained leaders equipped with heart, mind, and skills to guide them. Training leaders to minister to and help develop others is the most important task that we have. We train others through:

- Assisting with higher education where strategically important. Developing contextually appropriate educational models in partnership with national leaders.
- Providing solid biblical and theological training that is both practical and theologically sound.
- Conducting pastors' conferences, revivals, spiritual renewal meetings, and other special events as needed.
- Utilizing the learning and communication patterns of other cultures.

World Renewal has 14 hubs with two zones of influence. Our Mexico hub works with all of Latin America to train and build up leaders, and Entrusting Others is our partner hub for the 10/40 Window, also known as Challenging Countries. We are careful on sharing sensitive information about that area for the safety of our local leaders. In total, we work and partner with leaders in 60+ countries.

World Renewal Brazil is World Renewal's most mature field. Led by Tele Moraes, their goal is to plant 200 churches in Northeast Brazil. Since beginning in 1993, they have partnered with/planted 40+ churches. Their mission is to fulfill the Great Commission hand in hand with local Bible believing churches. World Renewal Brazil has sent missionaries to Mozambique and England, and includes a team of 20 families and seven missionary candidates. The representative: Rachel Ferguson, Church Ambassadors: Vicki Jordal (Community Church of Greenwood), and Greg Ruble (Brookville Road Community Church).

ENTRUSTING OTHERS (worldrenewal.org/entrusting-others)

Entrusting Others trains leaders and builds communities in strategic locations. We work in creative ways where others can't. We focus particularly on training people in local languages and cultures where not many people can read or write. Entrusting Others specializes in accompanying leaders as they help others, while passing on the baton of responsibility. The successful materials and methods we pioneered are being used in more than 40 countries. We are proud partners with World Renewal (since 2008) and TMS Global.



HAITI (worldrenewal.org/haiti)

Pastor Luc Joseph has planted and oversees 14 churches as well as Christ Compassion Orphanage with 26 children, plus 6 young adults attending further education. Pastor Maula Jean-Marie heads Genesis ministry, has 8 churches he oversees and pastors a church. He runs two schools for younger children and a daycare. Director: Luc Joseph, Representative: Max Wright, Church Ambassador: Paul Galbraith (Brandywine Community Church) . Advocates: Cora Condon, Wayne Stevens.



INDIA (worldrenewal.org/india)

Headquartered at the Living Hope campus in India, they have the Living Hope Theological College (with over 350 graduated missionaries reaching 2000 villages), Jaya Paramedical College (with over 1000 graduated nurses working in over 500 hospitals), the Dorcas Sewing training (with over 3000 impoverished women trained and given a sewing machine), and three Living Hope Children's homes, a primary school, and a VBS program that reaches thousands of children each year through Gospel friends in India, led by Gunah Kumar.



ISRAEL (worldrenewal.org/israel)

World Renewal partners with King of Kings Ministries, specifically in Herzliya with the G family. Their congregation, since Covid, is really growing. They added a second children's classroom to hold the large number of kids joining the Saturday service. Please pray for the community events they have to share the gospel, that ears will be open to hear, and the veil would be removed. You can watch their weekly service on YouTube. FRANCE (worldrenewal.org/france)

The Jones family is based in France, reaching out to far places. Andrew is reaching North Africa's unreached peoples through media, production, and distribution of audiovisual content in the "Forgotten Five," the five key unreached Berber peoples of Africa. Pascale is a volunteer with the Jews for Jesus team in France. Her main work is one-to-one sharing and discipleship of Jewish women.



KENYA (worldrenewal.org/kenya)

World Renew works with two different ministries in Kenya, with the Turkana people, and with Kibera Kids: For \$40 a month (or more) you can help support students at Mamlaka primary school, located in the largest urban slum in Africa: Kibera Kenya. Ninety percent of the money given goes directly into the account of the Mamlaka Foundation and is used to provide for the students at the school, teacher salaries, funding the meal program, emergency medical assistance, and other needs that may arise.

The Turkana are a proud and strong people. They live in a harsh semi-arid area of North Western Kenya. Keshule Edapal (who is Turkana) and his wife Ali and their family lived there for many years, serving, and continue to guide and support from the UK. The Turkana Community ministry is involved in Church Planting, using the model of friendship, evangelism, discipleship and mentoring. They offer adult literacy classes for both church members and non-members and minister through community gardens. Drew Fitzpatrick is the representative.



MOZAMBIQUE (worldrenewal.org/mozambique)

Assuerio Naque, our World Renew Brazil missionary since 1998, moved to Mozambique with Mirian, his wife, in 2017. They are training and working with leaders all over South Africa. The goal is to help the church in Mozambique and the rest of Africa to grow in healthy ways and to help leaders to grow in Biblical knowledge.



NICARAGUA (worldrenewal.org/nicaragua)

The Mendez family serves in Nicaragua through the International Leadership Institute (ILI), where Pastor Melvin is the National Coordinator. An average of 500 leaders are built up each year through mobilizing teams and training national leaders. Additionally, the Mendez family engages in crosscultural missions' mobilization, evangelism, discipleship training, and church planting.

Partnering with World Renew since 2001, Pastor Ramiro and Claudia Martinez help the Latin American church to strategically participate in God's mission locally and globally. They have a church planting ministry in the greater Mexico City area, and have planted over seven churches. Working with International Leadership Institute, they have trained over 3,000 leaders each year the past couple of years, and established multiplying teams in 11 Latin American countries. Larry Lux is the representative.

Cloud and Dina Roman, leaders of the Mwanzo Mpya Foundation (MMF) in Tanzania, run the Mwanzo Mpya Academy. How to Represent Others

A big goal with World Renewal is to have a thorough network of people representing each one of our missionaries, partners, and ministries. We call them representatives, advocates, and church ambassadors. Find more information about this at worldrenewal.org/represent-others.



Representative

Representatives are individuals who know a field intimately, and feel called to represent them in the USA. They can help support trips that go to that field, and receive partners from that field if they come visit the USA. They also help create and update different church ambassadors (people within a church that supports that partner/ministry) and advocates (people who want to support a partner/ministry that are outside of a church setting). This is a more intense roll that requires a serious investment of time and energy.



Church Ambassador

Church Ambassadors are those from inside a church that supports a ministry or partner, that works as a “point person” for their church, helping them know and support that ministry or partner well. They can also be a person who brings a ministry or partner in front of a church, to have them be “adopted” by that congregation.



Advocate

An Advocate is someone who is not working within a church system to support a ministry or partner, but feels led to “Take the next step” after being a donor and to really concentrate on sharing about this ministry or partner with others in their sphere of influence.



How to Give

It is important for you to know how to give to World Renewal so you can share with others how to give! Our public financial statement is at the bottom of the "Our Board" page, under "Who" on the website. World Renewal has received the Candid gold transparency badge, as a good NGO to donate to.
